1. POLICY DEVELOPMENT/REVIEW



Animal breeders want bigger economic bite

HCM City, 08/03/08: The animal husbandry sector targets a higher share of all agricultural products

to 42 percent and 32 percent by 2010 and 2020, respectively. Dr. Hoang Kim Giao, Director General of the Animal Husbandry Department-MARD, said: "To reach the goal, the sector would have to achieve an annual growth rate of 8-9 percent to 2010 and 6-7 percent from 2010-2015.

In order to reach those goals, the sector would have to produce 3.2 million tonnes of meat of various kinds, 380,000 tonnes of fresh milk and 7 billion eggs in 2010.

It would have to produce 5.5 million tonnes of meat, 1 million tonnes of milk and 14 billion eggs in 2020 to ensure the average per capita of 56 kilos of meat, 10.2 kilos of fresh milk and 140 eggs a year, Giao said.

The industry needs to follow industrial methods by building large-scale farms with modern farming technology, which would shield domestic herds of livestock from epidemics and ensure food safety and environmental protection, he said.

It should also create close relations between companies and farmers to develop professional

product distribution systems to facilitate breeders' consumption and stabilize market prices, Giao said. Giao said that specialized processes would be strictly controlled to ensure the quality of products as well as food hygiene and safety.

Farmers would be encouraged to use industrially processed feed and control epidemics, especially serious foot-and-mouth disease, avian flu, and respiratory and reproductive disorders.

More waste treatment systems would be built at breeding farms to increase the percentage of farms having treatment facilities to 45 percent in 2010 and 70 percent in 2015.

The industry plans to build large-scale commercial breeding areas in suitable climates and soil, such as northern Midland area, Central Highlands , and several northern and southeastern provinces.

The industry has already established a legal framework on the management of animal breeders and feed.

2. BILATERAL COOPERATION

Gov't direction on IFAD aid

Ha Noi, 07/03/08: Deputy Prime Minister Pham Gia Khiem has assigned relevant agencies to

work with the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) to ensure aid projects begin by November this year.

In a document released by the Government Office on March 6, Deputy PM Khiem urged for steps to be taken to ensure the IFAD's 100-million-USD aid commitments for 2008-2012 are used effectively.

He named the Ministry of Planning and Investment as the key authority to work with the ministries of Finance, Agriculture and Rural Development, and Foreign Affairs, as well as the Government Office and other responsible agencies to ensure smooth reception of the IFAD funding.

These agencies will work with the IFAD on qualification for aid beneficiaries and submit a list of eligible provinces for government approval in March.

The ministries must also finalize a draft national framework of cooperation with the IFAD for 2008-2012.

VN, Ukraine advance aquaculture cooperation

Ha Noi, 04/03/08: Viet Nam and Ukraine have signed an agreement to boost cooperation on fisheries and aquaculture.

The agreement's key initiatives include information exchange and technology transfer in fisheries, especially in bio-chemistry technologies. It also involves sharing training on aquaculture.

The agreement was signed by the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development and the Ukraine Aquaculture Economic Committee (UAEC) in Ha Noi on March 4.

The two sides said they hoped cooperation between Vietnamese and Ukrainian enterprises would strengthen and develop for the long-term.

According to UAEC President Volkov Vladimir Vasilievich, the Ukraine government plans to support coldwater fish breeding in Viet Nam.

Ukraine also hoped to share experiences with Viet Nam in fish-related diseases, maritime safety and fish processing.

They also showed interest in Viet Nam's exported aquatic products, such as tiger prawn, "basa" catfish and cobia fish.

Dak Nong gives ethnic people agricultural support



Dak Nong, 28/03/08: Central Highlands Dak Nong province has invested more than 4.3 million USD (70 billion VND) in a project to train ethnic farmers in agricultural production

techniques.

The five-year programme, assisted by the Danish International Development Assistance (DANIDA), has helped farmers in Krong No and Dak Nong districts implement sustainable, high-yield agricultural models.

Starting from 2007, the programme is expected to improve living standards of poor ethnic people in the province.

Rubber plantation to stretch by 100,000ha

HCM City, 15/03/08: Rubber plantation will be expanded to a total of 100,000ha by 2010, according to a recent decision made by the Ministry of Agriculture

and Rural Development and the Gia Lai People's Committee.

Since 2006, companies in the Central Highlands planted 5,500 ha of rubber trees, out of the targeted 100,000, according to the Central Highlands' Steering Committee.

The conference was told the rubber industry must consult local residents about policies and be sensitive to the needs of ethnic minorities.

Over VND 139 billion invested into forestry extension


Hanoi 24.03.08: The Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development has approved the proposal for forestry extension during 2008-2010 and orientation up to 2020, with the investment amounts up to VND 139 billion for stage 2008-2010.

The fund will be invested into the training of forestry extensionists; construction of demonstrative models, training of forest owners; information and communication in forestry extension; support to the forestry extension and setting up the pilot model.

The objectives of the project are to upgrade the skills of management, development and protection of the forest for 80% of the forest owners (800,000 persons); to designate at least one forestry extensionist for each commune and to improve the capacity for voluntary forestry extensionist system; to attract 50% of the forestry enterprises of various economic elements and mass organizations to take part in the forestry extension activities.

Italy-funded agricultural project benefits Thua Thien-Hue

Thua Thien-Hue, 20/03/08: An

Italian-funded agricultural development and irrigation project is helping improve the living standards of 1,300 poor families in central Thua Thien Hue province.

The 2.6-million-EUR project is being carried out in Phu Vang district's Vinh Ha, Vinh Thai and Phu Da communes from 2007-2009.

This year, the project will focus on Vinh Thai commune and upgrade pumping stations, build and dredge canals, construct a drainage system and strengthen the local dyke.

Earlier, in Vinh Ha commune, the project ran 44 farming training courses for more than 1,300 people, as well as built 150 pig pens and provided 300 farmers with loans to develop livestock breeding.

Under the project, irrigation has also been built and put into use to assist growth and drainage of 400ha of rice.

The Italian Foreign Ministry is putting 1.5 million EUR toward the project and Italian organisation GVC providing 414,600 EUR.

6. FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT

Solutions to speed up FDI disbursement rate



Hanoi, 25/03/08: proposal to speed up the disbursement rate of foreign direct investment (EDI) conital is be

direct investment (FDI) capital is being considered by the Ministry of Planning and Investment (MPI).

With the number of projects and registered capital on the increase, especially since Viet Nam joined the World Trade Organisation, it is hoped the scheme will break slow FDI disbursement.

Foreign Investment Department (FID) Head, Phan Huu Thang said the proposal classifies and puts forward assistance policies suitable to projects in each locality, with priorities given to key ones that have great impact on localities and regions.

In a press briefing held at the end of last year, Minister of Planning and Investment said that speeding up the disbursement rate is a key ministry task in 2008 alongside selecting investment projects to benefit economic development.

As a result, the ministry only set a modest target of attracting 15 billion USD in FDI, 5 billion USD less than last year's figure.

67 million USD for Central Highlands plantations

Kon Tum, 04/03/08: Plans for a new tree plantation to supply the paper industry are underway for the Central Highlands province of Kon Tum.

The InnovGreen Kon Tum company has pledged to invest 67 million USD in the slated plantation.

According to the province's Department of Planning and Investment, InnovGreen Kon Tum has completed field work to rent a 65,000ha area, crossing 52 communes of the province, for 50 years.

The plantation project, the largest ever in Kon Tum, is expected to provide jobs for ethnic minority groups and contribute to poverty reduction and socio-economic development.

This year, local authorities gave the nod to three other investors for developing similar material forests in Kon Tum province.

Company targets 10,000 ha of rubber trees in Laos

Vientiane, 12/03/08: The Dau Tieng Viet-Laos Rubber Joint Stock Company is set to plant 4,000 ha of rubber

trees in 2008 in an effort to fulfill its goal of planting 10,000 ha in southern Champasak province of Laos.

Local authorities and people highly appreciated the company's project achievements, considering it as a cooperation model between Laos' Champasak province and Viet Nam's Binh Duong province, which has contributed to reduce poverty in the project site.

The Dau Tieng Viet-Laos company was established in June 2007 by Dau Tieng Rubber Company, Binh Duong Import-Export Company and Hung Vuong Joint Stock Company. It had planted 2,300 ha of rubber trees by the end of last year.

Fisheries food plant opens in Mekong province

Tien Giang, 07/03/08: The Higashimaru Viet Nam Ltd Company, located in the Tan Huong Industrial Zone, has inaugurated its fisheries food processing plant in the Mekong Delta province of Tien Giang.

This 4 million USD plant will, in the first phase, have a capacity to produce between 10,000 and 15,000 tonnes per year.

In the second phase, Higashimaru Viet Nam Ltd Co will increase its investment of 10 million USD to increase the capacity to 50,000 tonnes per year.

PM requests higher efficiency in Vietnam-Lao investment

Hanoi, 22/03/08: Prime Minister Nguyen Tan Dung has said Vietnam and Laos should work harder to increase the efficiency in their investment cooperation.

During a meeting with the visiting Lao Minister of Planning and Investment, Soulivong Daravong, in Hanoi on March 22, the PM asked the two ministries of Planning and Investment to increase the exchange of information and strengthen their cooperation and mutual assistance.

The Lao Minister informed the PM of the results of his Vietnam visit, particularly the signing of a cooperative agreement for 2008 between his ministry and its Vietnamese counterpart.

He said close ties between the two ministries have helped boost economic cooperation between the two countries, especially in power, mining and industrial crops.

Taiwanese firm gets green light for tree plantation

Kon Tum, 21/03/08: Central Highlands Kon Tum provincial authorities on March 21 granted a licence to Taiwan 's InnovGreen Kon Tum company to build a tree plantation in the locality.

Accordingly, the company will invest over 1 trillion VND (67 million USD) in developing a tree plantation to serve the paper industry.

The plantation will span 65,000ha, crossing 52 communes in seven districts, including Dak Glei, Dak Ha, Dak To, Kon Ray, Ngoc Hoi, Sa Thay, Tu Mo Rong and Kon Tum town.

The project, the largest of its kind in Kon Tum province so far, will be implemented between now and 2017.

In addition to the tree plantations, InnovGreen Kon Tum will cultivate seedlings, process wood, produce paper pulp and manage export and import activities.

InnovGreen Kon Tum is the only wholly-foreign-invested company licensed in Kon Tum province since the Investment and Enterprise Law came into effect.

7. EXPORTS PERFORMANCE

Two-month aquatic product exports fetch 550 mln. USD



Ha Noi, 03/03/08: Viet Nam earned around 295 million USD from aquatic product export in February, bringing the total export value of the products for the past two months to 550 million USD.

The Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development said the US , Japan and European countries remained Viet Nam 's big aquatic product consumers.

According to the Viet Nam Association of Seafood Exporters and Processors, prolonged cold weather since early this year has affected aquatic product output, pushing the prices up by 30-50 percent on the domestic market.

Increasing the Export of Agricultural Products for Curbing the Inflation

Hanoi, 20.3.2008: Prime Minister Nguyen Tan Dung emphasized that the agriculture sector had to motivate the strengths in agricultural production, husbandry, and sea products to increase the export volume so as to help curb the inflation and accelerate economic growth.

Working with the MARD leaders on March 20, 2008, PM pointed out that the agriculture had to stabilize the prices of the agricultural commodities and food and ensure the food safety, to avoid the price increase, to ensure the cereal collection at manageable prices for the farmers.

The Prime Minister assigned the Ministry of Finance with the task to work out a proposal for rice export, temporary cancellation of signing new export

contract, to ensure the maximum export of 3.5 million tons of rice by October 2008 and to mobilize the support to stricken areas in the situation of high rising prices.

The PM confirmed that the current foremost priority of the government was to concentrate on curbing the inflation, at least at a level lower than the previous year, and not to affect the growth rate of 8-8.5%.

Dutch help HCM City export fresh food

HCM City, 13/03/08: A Netherlands company with expertise in promoting exports from developing countries to the European Union, will help Ho Chi Minh City boost shipments of flowers, vegetables and fruit to the bloc.

Under an agreement signed between the Netherlands CBI and the HCM City Agricultural Consultancy and Support Centre (HCACS) on March 13, the southern city will be helped to improve its fresh food export management and marketing skills.

HCACS Director Tu Minh Thien says the agreement will tap the international organisation's resources to improve the competitiveness and production efficiency of small- and medium-sized enterprises and farm produce.

Thien said the three year-long programme from 2008-2010 will also help his organisation improve its working capacity and expand an alliance of relevant agencies.

The alliance is comprised of organisations that support local enterprises and agricultural management agencies that have a strong potential to export to the EU.

Ho Chi Minh City is among the largest flower producers and the largest consumer and transit market in Viet Nam.

Japan signs free trade agreement with ASEAN

Hanoi, 28/03/08: Japan signed a free trade agreement with the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN)

to promote trade and investment between the two sides, news reports said on March 28.

Under the accord, Japan will eliminate tariffs on 93 percent of imports from ASEAN by value within 10 years, while six ASEAN members, including Brunei, Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore and Thailand, will abolish tariffs on 90 percent of imports from Japan within 10 years in terms of both value and the number of items.

The document, inked by Japanese Foreign Minister Masahiko Komura on behalf of Japan, is expected to be endorsed by respective ASEAN members within April. It will come into effect in Autumn, news reports said.

The deal was finalized last November after two and a half years of negotiations. The two sides have been fine-tuning the wording and other procedures since then.

ASEAN groups Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, the Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam.

Australians plan agricultural research co-operation effort



Ha Noi, 07-03-08: Australia's International Agricultural

Research Centre will spend US\$3 million this year in its work in co-operation with Viet Nam.

The work will be based on the results of a two-day conference between the Viet Nam Agricultural Sciences Academy, the Binh Dinh Province People's Committee and the centre that finished in Quy Nhon City yesterday.

Purpose of the conference was to enhance the co-operation programme between Viet Nam and Australia on the central-southern coast.

More than 20 scientific reports about Viet Nam's agriculture – its present status potential and development – were tabled at the conference.

Most dealt with the central-southern coast and the remote north-west where poverty is high and Australian expertise is valued.

The conference reviewed the results of the institute's research and ways of enhancing its cooperation with districts, communes and mass organisations in agriculture.

The meeting also worked to develop the agriculture promotion and communication programmes.

The conference agreed to begin development of a major agriculture project in 2012.

HCM City, 14/03/08: The Viet Nam International Furniture and Home Accessories Fair 2008 opened at the Phu Tho Indoor Sport Stadium in Ho Chi Minh City on March 14.

Over 550 booths of 150 local and foreign companies from 44 countries and territories display their indoor and outdoor furniture, wood fine art

articles, china and machinery and equipment for wood manufacturing and processing.

Workshops on the woodwork industry, a competition on designing wood fine art goods and field trips to wood processing plants in Viet Nam will be held during the four-day fair.

Coffee export surge on horizon

Hanoi, 26/03/08: The chance to boost exports is within the reach of Vietnam's coffee industry due to a decline in world productivity and good export prices, according to the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development (MARD).

At a coffee industry workshop held in Hanoi on March 26, MARD Deputy Minister Diep Kinh Tan said the country's coffee output has kept increasing thanks to improved quality and scale of production, making Vietnam the second largest coffee exporter in the world.

Tan said as a result, Vietnam's coffee has played an important role in the world market. However, the industry needs to ensure sustainable growth in 2008 and future years to stabilize exports.

During the workshop, coffee producers from Vietnam and Brazil , the world's largest exporter, shared market development experiences and discussed development strategies for Vietnam's coffee industry.

Last year, Vietnam earned 1.8 billion USD in coffee exports, increasing earnings by 50 percent from 2006. The industry posted an export value of 795 million USD in the first quarter of 2008.

Workshop heats discussion over 2008 coffee sales

Ha Noi, 13/03/08: Measures to secure a place for Viet Nam 's coffee in the world market for 2008 will be discussed at a two-day workshop for the industry in Ha Noi from March 26.

The workshop will be attended by government officials, coffee growers, processors and traders.

The purpose of the workshop is to brief participants about the prevailing and potential world market for coffee, said Agriculture and Rural Development Policy and Strategy Institute deputy director Duong Ngoc Thi on March 12.

"We'll update the Government's policy and strategy for coffee development, particularly measures to consolidate the organisation of the coffee chain," the deputy director said.

The workshop would also provide a venue for government officials, researchers, scientists, business people and international representatives to meet and exchange their ideas.

"This is a good and effective channel to collect information for decision makers," he said.

MOUs between Viet Nam and Brazil 's Agricultural Ministries were scheduled to be signed at the meeting with the aim of promoting cooperation between the two countries in sustainable development and minimising risks for coffee growers and agents.

Viet Nam is the world's second largest coffee producer.

The crop provides revenue for about 600,000 farmers and employment for more than one million people.

It accounts for about 8 percent of the total value of the country's agricultural produce and about 20 percent of export revenue.

Viet Nam exported 1.2 million tonnes of coffee bean and earned 1.8 billion USD - 350 million USD higher than rice exports – last year.

Seminar on sustainable poverty reduction

Thanh Hoa, 23/03/08: Many measures to speed up the poverty reduction process in Vietnam were recommended by a recent seminar on sustainable poverty reduction in central Thanh Hoa province.

Minister of Labour, War Invalids and Social Affairs Nguyen Thi Kim Ngan and representatives from the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), Vietnamese ministries and branches and 60 districts that have the highest poverty rate in the country attended the two-day seminar that wrapped up on March 22.

Poor knowledge, low employment rate and the lack of scientific awareness and experiences for production are the reasons causing poverty in 60 districts across the country, said the participants.

Vietnam should implement its poverty reduction programme comprehensively by settling pressing issues and improving local people's knowledge along side with other measures, they suggested.

Strong investment should be poured into vocational training, job generation, infrastructure, agro-forestry and handicraft development and multiply effective economic models in 60 districts whose poverty rate stands at more than 50 percent, the participants noted.

They went on to emphasize the necessity that local authorities must effectively use the State investment capital.
